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Claude Branger Muscadet, Monnieres-St. Fiacre, <i>Loire Valley, France</i> 2014 <i>Melon d’ Bourgonge grown over gneiss. Smooth, but ample grip. Sweet grains, lemon, butter. Easy, yet urbane.</i>	58
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Meinklang Pinot Gris, “Graupert,” <i>Burgenland, Austria</i> 2018 <i>Orange wine. Tangy, rustic. Dried apricot, lemon, honey. Not your mother’s Pinot Grigio</i>	60
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Tement Sauvignon Blanc, <i>Grassnitzberg Vineyard, Südsteiermark, Austria</i> , 2014 <i>Closed mountain basin vineyard, limestone. Tensile. Herbs and caper salt. A chef’s Sauvignon</i>	80
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Failla Chardonnay, <i>Hudson Vineyard, Carneros, California</i> 2012 <i>Single Vineyard. Rich, viscous. Hazelnuts, brown butter. Seashore cottage.</i>	118

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Day Zinfandel, <i>Sonoma, California</i> 2017 <i>Dry Creek and Russian River Valley fruit. Luscious and sappy, yet dry and proportioned. Black raspberries and cedar. Amorous</i>	60
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Aldo Conterno Barbera Conca Tre Pile, <i>Piedmont, Italy</i> 2017 <i>Singe vineyard. Powerful and firm. Damson plums, dark mincemeat. Beaujolais meets Zinfandel.</i>	65
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Colomé Malbec, “Auténtico,” <i>Valle Calchaqui, Salta, Argentina</i> 2019 <i>No oak, old vines. Inky and precise. Blackberries, allspice, bay. Thoroughbred.</i>	75
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Serre Nuove del Onellaia, <i>Tuscany, Italy</i> 2016 <i>Merlot. Dense, fine woven. Cocktail cherry, balsam. Coiled, but elegant and demur.</i>	100
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Pierre Amadiou Gigondas, “Le Pas de l’Aigle Grande Réserve,” <i>Rhone, France</i> 2016 <i>Grenache over Gargasian blue marl. Expansive, generous. Berry, licorice, earth. Boom.</i>	80
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
